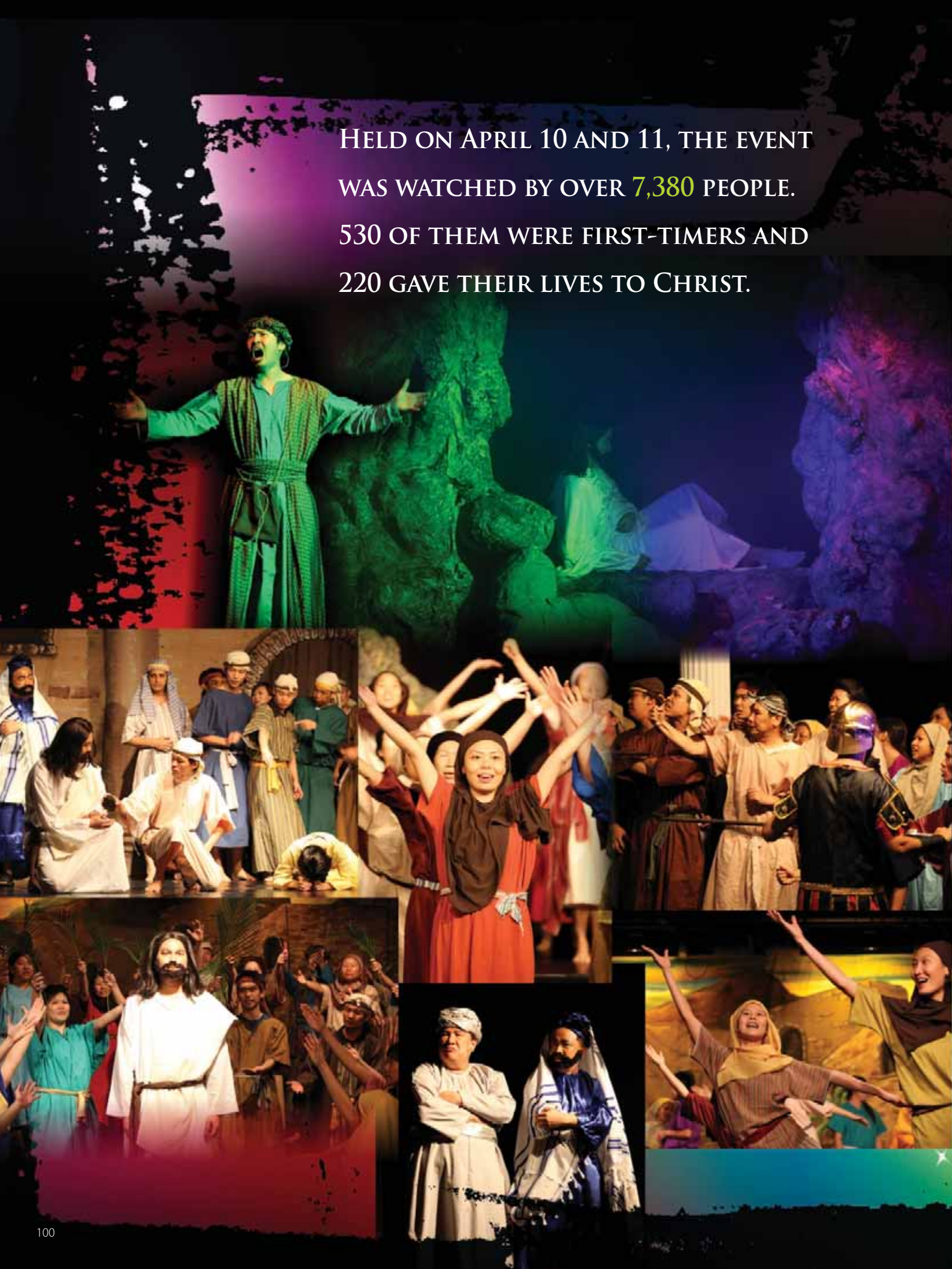
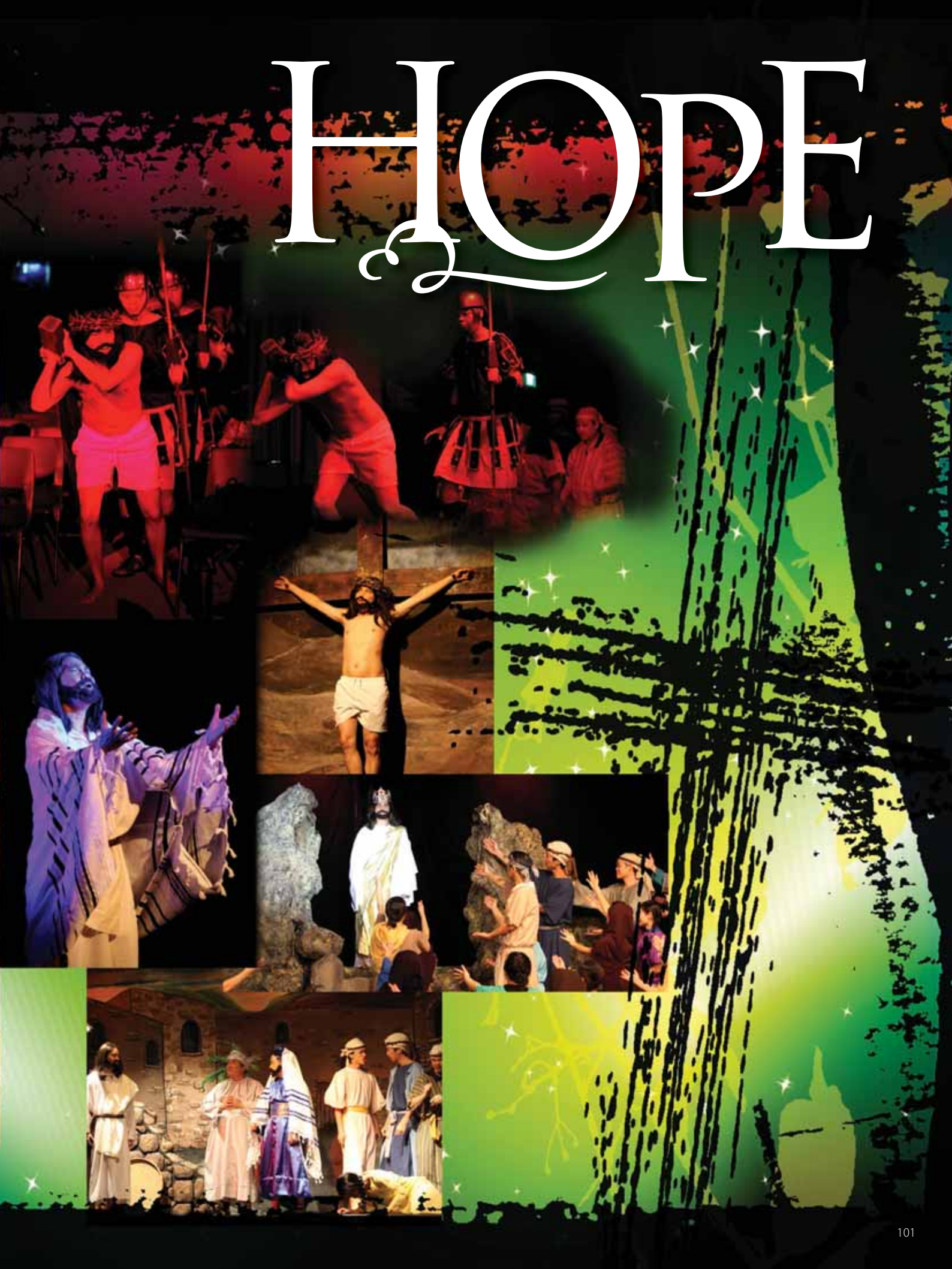

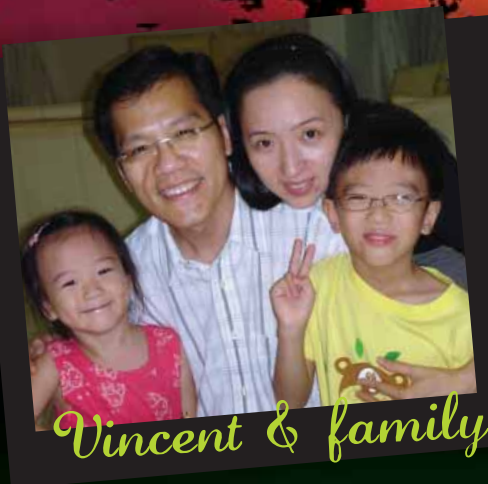
Gloria
